

Dear Colusa High Alumni,

Many of you are curious and have asked for an accounting of how Colusa High School curriculums benefit from our annual newsletter donations. We are sure that the desire to give back, comes from the fond memories experienced at Colusa High School and the hope that others will have the chance to enjoy a quality education.

A special thank you goes to alum Stan Goodin, Class of 1962, who put out a challenge to our alumni in the last newsletter. Stan offered to match any alumni donations of \$100 and \$250. He matched the donations up to a total of \$5000. Many alumni responded, increasing their annual donation, and made Stan's challenge a success!

It should be noted that Stan earmarked half of his donation (\$2500) for the Counseling Department. He wanted to make sure that this department was funded for all the students needing guidance during the recent school disruptions. 














New Colusa High School Principal
